Transcripts, records, letters of reference, and standardized test scores should be sent to University College Graduate Admissions.

Required personal statement (required for all applicants): In a one- to two-page essay, describe your educational goals, including your reasons for applying to the graduate program you have selected. Describe previous educational and professional experiences that are relevant to your proposed course of study, as well as other factors that have influenced your decision to pursue graduate study at this point in your life. Please attach a separate page if necessary.

Academic writing sample: Required for applicants to the American Culture Studies, International Affairs, and Master of Arts in Liberal Arts programs only.

If you are applying for admission to one of these graduate programs, please submit an additional writing sample, three (3) pages minimum, according to the following:

- **American Culture Studies:** Please submit a recent academic writing sample, preferably one that's research based.
- **International Affairs:** Please submit a relevant and recent academic writing sample, preferably one that is research based **or** an original essay in which you analyze a current international issue or problem.
- **Master of Arts in Liberal Arts.:** Please submit an original essay that answers the following question:
What important idea, discovery, or work of art (including music and literature) has made a difference in your life and why?
